It shows where you are and some nearby/noteworthy park features that you might be trying to find as well as some other nearby practical destinations such as where your tent might be pitched or your car might be parked. Once you get closer to those other locations, you could obviously download a new map that is 'centered' in that location which shows park features beyond the boundaries of what this one shows. The scale is not to scale; it's just on here for illustrative purposes. The letters correspond to what the hiker will see on the trail junction navigation signs. When we are talking about this with Jay/Russell, we can use something like this as an example of what you think you could deliver. If you set this up and send me a QR code via email that ties to this map on your server. I'll try to call it up the next time I'm in the field and see what gets delivered to my cell phone.
