National Weather Service - National Water Model Flood Inundation Mapping. The National Weather Service is taking the next step in the process that began years ago with the creation of the National Water Model; forecast Flood Inundation Mapping. South Central Texas is in the initial release of these products that will be available October 1 with a target of 100% of the US population by 2026. Three different types of inundation mapping will be made available to partners and public alike. This presentation will give an introduction of these products as well as cover known deficiencies and where you can access the data to allow importing them into your existing GIS services.
